


Explore the history of your local area – this could be your street, neighbourhood, village, town or city. Try to find out what makes it unique.

Draw the treasures in the boxes and write down what they are and a cool fact about them.


Now, create something which is inspired by these treasures. It could be cooking/baking something, writing a poem or crafting something.


ZERO WASTE


