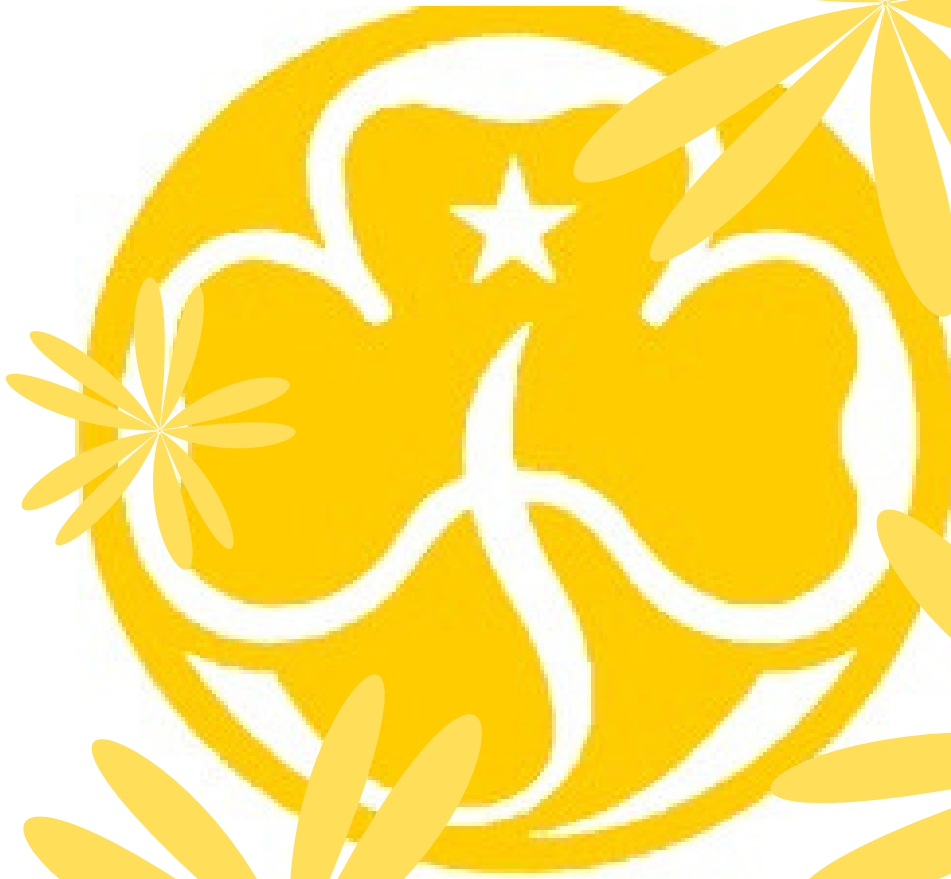

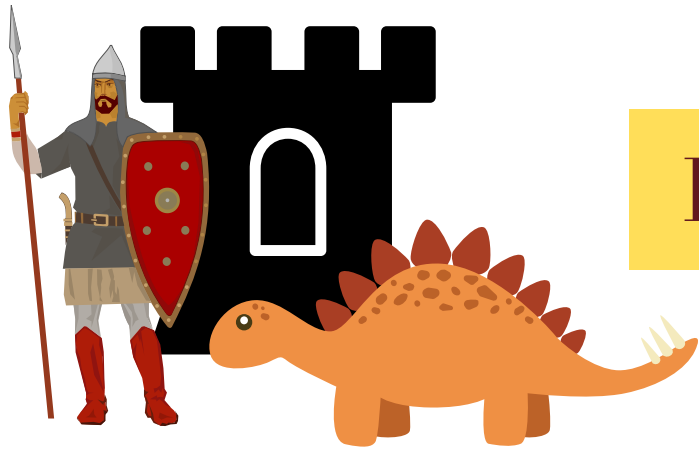

# LOCAL HISTORY

Explore the history of your local area – this could be your street, neighbourhood, village, town or city. Try to find out what makes it unique. Complete the following challenges to earn your badge:

## LANDMARKS:

Take photographs or draw pictures of different landmarks in your chosen local area and use these to create a map. You could do a dotted line to show where you walked and stick the photos/pictures to the page where they should be on your route.

Be prepared to tell Brown Owl which was your favourite landmark and something cool you found out about it! Write it down to help you remember.

## TREASURES:

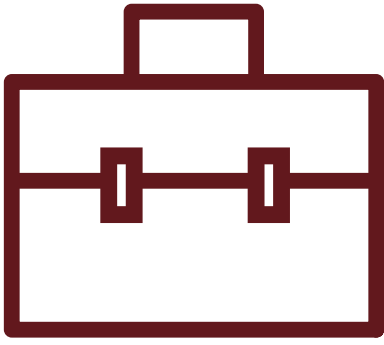
Find out about 2 treasures in your local area. These treasures could be a myth/legend, something that was found in the ground, a local food or traditional craft. Write down what these treasures are below.

Interview 3 different adults about their jobs. Use the interview sheet to help. Write down your answers to show Brown Owl.

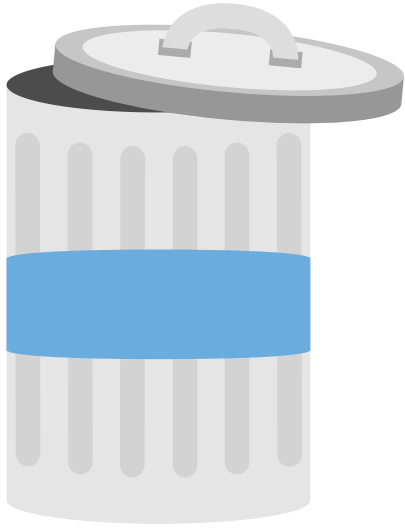
## **DREAM JOB:**

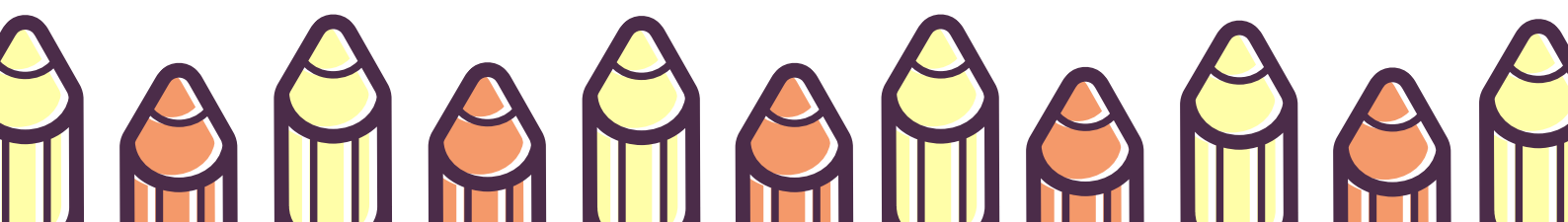

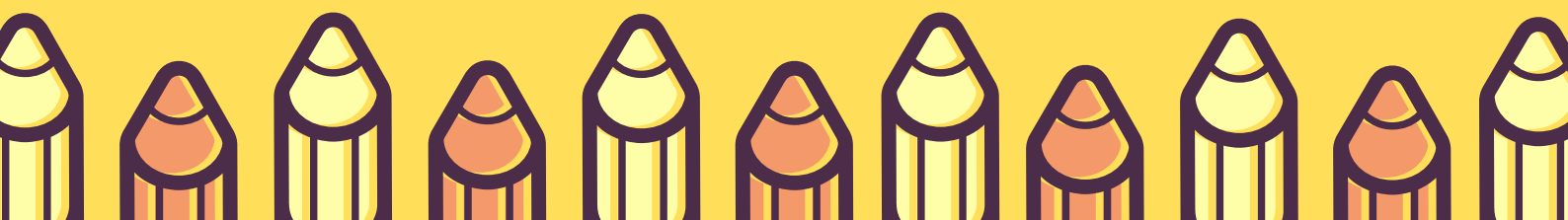
